Rules and Regulations for Visitors

- No person shall introduce or cause to be introduced into or upon the property of a Detention Facility, or give any inmate, any article of contraband; or give any inmate anything which is not specifically authorized, in writing by the Administrative Commander or designee, Florida State Statute 951.22 Introduction of Contraband into Detention Facility is a Felony, and can receive criminal charges.
- Florida State Statute 951.22 Visitors are subject to be searched. Any visitor who enters the Jail Facility with contraband will be subject to either immediate removal from the facility, suspension of future visitation privileges, and possible criminal charges.
- Visitors must sign in at the visitation desk and present to visitation personnel a valid, current Government issued photo I.D.
- Profanity, yelling and any other loud or disorderly conduct are not permitted and could cause the visit to be terminated.
- Cell phones, or any other items of property are not allowed inside the Jail Facility.
- Visitation is a privilege. Visits may be denied, revoked or limited when the visit would threaten safety, security or the good order of the facility or when visitation rules are not followed.
- An adult parent or legal guardian must accompany any person under the age of 18.
- Proper attire is required for all visitors. Visitation personnel will make the final decision on questionable attire. Visitation may be denied for inappropriate dress. Shorts and skirts

of reasonable length are allowed, not less than approximately 2 inches above the knee. No revealing or see through tops, tank tops or sports bras (worn as a top) or swim suits will be allowed. Footwear is required.

- Inmates are allowed (2) two social visits per session; (2) two sessions per week. Each session is 60 minutes long. Visits are non-contact.
- No person who has been incarcerated within the last 60 days is allowed to visit an inmate at this facility. You will also be denied visitation if you are attempting to visit a Co-defendant. If you are the Protected Person/Victim of an Injunction or No-Contact-Order you will not be permitted visitation with the Respondent/Defendant.
- No personal checks or cash will be accepted at the visitation booth. There is a reverse ATM KIOSK locate inside the Sheriff's Office Lobby. You may deposit money into an inmate's commissary account using cash or your debit/credit card at the Kiosk.
